#### **EMPLOYEES**

Officers made 69 arrests during the month on warrants for Pantego offenses and on warrants from other agencies.

Officers made 54 alarm calls during the month.

Officers reported 13 open doors or suspicious vehicles or persons near businesses or in the residential areas.

### **OTHER ITEMS OF INTEREST**

In the late night hours of June 29, Officer Sam Nance helped remove three juveniles from a dangerous situation they found themselves in near the park. The three young males became trapped between the deep rushing water of Rush Creek and a fence that they could not climb over or go through. Officer Nance helped them through a couple of narrow passage ways, since they could not see very well in the dark and rain, and was finally successful in getting them back on safe ground. There were no injuries but all three lost their shoes in the swift water.

In the early morning hours of June 29, Officer Pokey Lawrence responded to a call on Wagonwheel Trail where a seven year old child was found wandering alone away from the safety of his home. Officer Lawrence was quickly able to find the frantic parents and return the child safely.

On June 3, 2010, Sergeant Chad Hoya stopped a south bound vehicle in the 2400 Block of W Park Row Drive for speeding. As a result of his investigation he charged the female driver with Manufacture and Deliver of Controlled Substances, Possession of Dangerous Drugs and Possession of Marijuana. In addition to the illegal contraband found in the vehicle, Sergeant Hoya also found \$2,500.00 cash which was seized pending further investigation.

On June 12, 2010, Sergeant Chad Hoya and Officer Sam Nance stopped a north bound vehicle in the 1400 Block of S Bowen Road after observing several traffic violations. Their investigation resulted in several felony charges being filed on the driver and occupants, to include, Possession of Controlled Substances, Manufacture and Deliver of Controlled Substances and Failure to Identify. This stop also resulted in the seizure of the vehicle, a 1997 Ford Mustang, pending further investigation.
