EMPLOYEES

TRAINING

- **March 23 through 26, 2010, Sergeants Barry Reeves and Chad Hoya and Chief McKinney attended 28 hours each State and Local Anti-Terrorism Training – Investigative/Intelligence. This training was provided by the Bureau of Justice Assistance, U.S. Department of Justice and was held in Arlington.**
- **Chief McKinney attended 40 hours Police Chief Administrative Training in Huntsville at Sam Houston State University. This training was held March 8 through 12, 2010.**
- **Dispatcher Kobre Hodge completed 16 hours training March 28 and 29 to become a Certified Communications Training Officer. This training was held at the 911 Training Center in Fort Worth.**
